Ahmed N Al Nemah: Acting Undersecretary, Civil Aviation Affairs



The Civil Aviation Affairs (CAA) is the Kingdom of Bahrain's aviation regulator which oversees all aspects of aviation. In his capacity as Acting Undersecretary, Ahmed N. Al Nemah is responsible for overseeing the strategic development of Aviation Services in the Kingdom of Bahrain. We look into some of the various aspects in his position as Acting Undersecretary, Bahrain Ministry of Transportation, Civil Aviation Affairs.

Ahmed N. Al Nemah is the Acting Undersecretary of Civil Aviation Affairs. A veteran in the aviation industry, Mr Al Nemah has been with CAA for almost 35 years.

He started his career as an Air Traffic Controller and in 2001 was appointed as the Director of Air Transport. In 2005, he was promoted to the Assistant Undersecretary for Aviation Services and in 2013 was appointed to his current position.

Mr Al Nemah is on the board of the Middle East Regional Monitoring Agency which was established as the regional monitoring centre in Bahrain in 2005. CAA manages the operations centre that has been collecting and analysing radar and flight data including height monitoring to ensure that aircraft flying in the region maintain the assigned altitudes and that all aircraft have the required certification to operate in the reduced vertical separation minima airspace. The centre, operated by Bahraini nationals, has been equipped with latest technologies and systems.



He is also instrumental at developing and implementing open skies policy for the Kingdom including securing the interest of the national carrier Gulf Air in the international market through bilateral negotiations. In addition, his responsibilities include successful negotiations of various bilateral agreements and achieving open skies with nations worldwide. He reports to the Minister of Transportation.

Under the patronage of His Majesty the King of the Kingdom of Bahrain, CAA hosts the Bahrain International Airshow every two years in partnership with Farnborough International UK. The event offers a great boost to the economy, both direct and indirect. This year CAA presented a bigger and better event which brought together civil and military delegations from all over the world.

Organisers confirmed that business agreements generated at the show were almost three times up on the total in 2012. With over 100 international and

domestic companies present at the show, it was noted that the increase was a real reflection of the event's importance to the Middle Eastern aviation market. Meetings and networking were also a key feature of the show with over 130 delegations from 32 countries participating in a programmed series of meetings and events.

Aircraft participation also increased with 89 aircraft on the static display and a total of 106 aircraft participating in the show. Visitor numbers reached record highs with over 30,000 visitors attending the trade show and over 20,000 attending the public event.

CAA recently hosted the ICAO and the WCO's second Joint Conference on Enhancing Air Cargo Security and Facilitation in Manama, Bahrain. Mr Al Nemah was on the panel discussing the solutions to address current and future challenges for Air Cargo Security and Felicitation. Looking forward into the future, Mr Al Nemah strongly feels

INTERVIEW

Bahrain's role in regional aviation is tied to the development of Bahrain International Airport which is foreseen to undergo two stages. First, the development of the airport from its current peak capacity of servicing 8 million passengers annually to 13.5 million which is expected to be completed by 2018. The development is expected to be able to continuously hold the inflow of passengers until 2033. After this, the second phase is expected to kick in where a new airport will be constructed north of the current airport in Muharraq.

There are currently 44 international flight destinations from Bahrain with 1,040 arrival and departure flights daily. Around 40 airlines are operating in the airport with Gulf Air representing almost 50 per cent of the total flights.

Announces Additional Aircraft Order

Cathay Pacific Airways announced that it has ordered four aircrafts from The Boeing Company as part of its ongoing fleet modernisation programme. Following the announcement regarding the purchase of 21 Boeing 777-9X aircraft, the airline confirmed that it will also purchase another three Boeing 777-300ER airplanes along with one more Boeing 747-8 freighter.

The price of these additional purchases is HK\$7.4 billion at listed prices. The airline expects to take delivery of the three Boeing 777-300ERs in 2015 and the Boeing 747-8 freighter in 2016.

Both aircraft types are already extensively employed by Cathay Pacific on its long-haul passenger and freighter routes. The airline currently operates 38 Boeing 777-300ERs and with this latest purchase will have 15 more of the type on order for delivery between 2014 and 2015.

Cathay Pacific Chief Executive John Slosar said: "We are very pleased to confirm this latest aircraft purchase from The Boeing Company. Both the 777-300ER and the 747-8F offer a highly efficient solution on Cathay Pacific's ultra-long-haul routes, combining superb operating economics with a significant reduction in emissions.



These two aircraft types will form the backbone of our long-haul passenger and freighter fleets through to the end of the decade."

The latest freighter purchase means that Cathay Pacific will operate 14 Boeing 747-8Fs by 2016. Both aircraft types deliver improved payload range capability at competitive operating costs, along with a reduced impact on the environment.

As of December, the Cathay Pacific fleet is consists of 140 wide-body aircraft. Following the latest purchase announcement, the airline is set to take delivery of a total of 93 aircraft from 2014 to 2024, at an aggregate list price of approximately HK\$222 billion.

Sky Club Membership Options

Even with Delta's more than \$50 million investment over the last several years to renovate and expanding seating in existing Sky Clubs and build new Delta Sky Clubs around the system, customers have stated that the Clubs are overcrowded. To alleviate this problem and to maintain an exclusive atmosphere to the Sky Clubs, Delta has made the following changes to the Delta Sky Club membership options that will be effective immediately.

- Membership cost is \$695 annually. This Executive Membership will continue to allow two complimentary guests.
- For those customers who rarely need guest access, an Individual Membership at the current rate of \$450 will be introduced this spring. This membership will allow guest access for \$29 per guest Club visit.
- Beginning 1 May 2014, all customers who receive complimentary Delta Sky Club access as a benefit of their eligible credit or charge card will no longer receive complimentary guest access. A \$29 fee per guest Club visit will apply

In addition, members who qualified for Diamond Medallion status in 2013 for the 2014 Medallion year will continue to receive an Executive Membership through the end of the 2014 Medallion year on 28 February 2015. New service from Los Angeles

Delta announced it is continuing its expansion in Los Angeles by offering new daily nonstop service this summer in order to connect customers to all major U.S. tech centers and strengthen its Latin American network.

Beginning in June, Delta will be offering two daily flights between Austin, Texas and one daily flight between Boise, Idaho. Additionally, the airline will have daily nonstop service between San Salvador, El Salvador and Monterrey, Mexico, both pending government approval, in July.

"With direct access to all of the key U.S. tech markets as well as additional Latin service through our gateway at Los Angeles International Airport, we can continue to provide business and leisure customers with the best service options to meet their travel needs," said Bob Cortelyou, s.v.p.—Network Planning, in a release. "Los Angeles is a key market for Delta as we continue growing our presence on the U.S. West Coast."

With new service to Austin, Delta will now connect Los Angeles' growing Silicon Beach tech and startup community with all the major tech centres in the U.S., including: Boston, beginning on 5 June; New York; Oakland, California; Portland, Oregon; Salt Lake City; San Francisco; San Jose, California; Seattle; and now Austin. Additionally, customers in Austin, Boise, Monterrey and San Salvador will soon have one-stop service to Tokyo-Narita, Tokyo-Haneda, and Sydney through the airline's international gateway in Los Angeles.

Travellers through Los Angeles will enjoy the benefits of the \$229 million expansion and enhancement of Terminal 5 at LAX. The current project will double the size of the ticketing lobby and screening checkpoints, open an exclusive, separate Sky Priority lobby and checkpoint as well as include renovations to the Delta Sky Club and new baggage carousels. The project has already begun and is scheduled to take place in several phases with full completion in 2015.

Returns to Middle East

Described as the most cost-efficient wide-body aircraft in operation today, the A330-300 HGW is PAL's new flagship for medium-range routes. Celebrates A380 Launch to Zurich

Emirates, a global connector of people and places, celebrated the launch of its scheduled A380 service to Zurich from 8 January 2014, bringing the number of destinations it serves with its popular A380s to 25.



To Launch Flights to Los Angeles for Bahrain Travellers

Etihad Airways, the national airline of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), announced the launch from Bahrain to Los Angeles, California.

The expansion of its US operation will see the airline commencenon-stop daily flightsfrom Bahrain via its Abu Dhabi home-base (AUH) to Los Angeles (LAX) from June 1, 2014, subject to regulatory approvals.

The Californian city will be Etihad Airways' fourth US destination, joining Chicago, New York and Washington D.C, and will see the airline provide 28 return flights each week between the UAE and the US.

The announcement was made by James Hogan, Etihad Airways' President and Chief Executive Officerwho commented, "We are delighted to add Los Angeles, amajorUS and global destination with a significant metropolitan population and growing economy, to the

Etihad Airways' network in 2014. This expansion will see Etihad Airways offer air travellers daily flights, from our Abu Dhabi hub, to four destinations across the US.

The new service will increase Etihad Airways' operations in the US market by 33percent and cater for growing leisure and business traffic demands in Los Angeles, as well as the considerable catchment area of the city."

Los Angeles, one of the world's most iconic, popular, and multicultural destinations with ametropolitan population area of more than 18 million people, is the second largest in the US.

It is classified as a 'global city' with strengths in business, international trade, entertainment, culture, media, fashion, science, sports, technology, education, medicine and research.



New Premium Economy Class



After the presentation of the new Premium Economy Class at this year's ITB in Berlin, it's time for the next step. The new travel class can now be booked on flights flown by Boeing 747-8s. From 10 December, the Premium Economy Class will have guaranteed

availability on all flights served by the new jumbo. The destinations that can now be booked include the routes from Frankfurt to and from Buenos Aires, Chicago, Hong Kong, Mexico City, São Paulo, Seoul, Beijing and Washington, D.C.

From late January 2015, the first retrofitted aircraft of the type A340-600 are scheduled to take off from Munich for Hong Kong, Shanghai and Tokyo; from late April the A380-800 is planned to then fly from Frankfurt to Johannesburg, New York, Miami, Houston, San Francisco, Shanghai and Singapore. The Middle East routes are also slated to receive the new Premium Economy in 2015.
